THE PRESIDENT OF SURGITAL ROMANA TAMBURINI IS ONE OF THE PROTAGONISTS OF “UNA MARCIA IN PIÙ - STORIE ITALIANE DI IMPRENDITRICI VINCENTI”

The new book, presented yesterday in Milan, explains how the lady of frozen fresh pasta transformed a small artisan workshop into a company of international standing, which today serves professional kitchens all over the world. An example of pragmatism and know-how typical of the Romagna culture.

Lavezzola (RA), 23rd November 2022 – Romana Tamburini, founder, and current president of Surgital, is featured in the **new book 'Una marcia in più - Storie italiane di imprenditrici vincenti'** written by Manila Alfano, Giorgio Gandola and Stefano Zurlo, published by Antonella Di Leo Tursini. The **'lady of fresh pasta made in Romagna'** was included by the authors **among the successful women** described in the book, in which the intertwining of personal and professional history, almost always inextricably linked, is described.

The **book was presented yesterday in Milan** at Palazzo Barozzi - Fondazione Istituto dei Ciechi, with the participation of the protagonists who, in different capacities, found their place in the narrative. The debate was **chaired by Antonella Di Leo Tursini and Nicoletta Poli Poggiaroni**. Throughout the pages emerges all the uniqueness of a self-made woman, since 1980. In that year, in an artisan tortellini workshop of 45 square metres in Lavezzola - a small town near Ravenna - **together with her husband Edoardo Bacchini** (CEO of the company), she started a business that today, thanks to the most innovative deep-freezing techniques, brings **the Italian dish par excellence into the kitchens of the world's best chefs**.

Eyes forward looking, with her head held high, and feet on the ground: the aspect of Romana that emerges in the narrative is certainly her **pragmatism**, what has always allowed her to realise new projects, and which has enabled her to evolve as an entrepreneur and her company to become an international business. Those who know Romana well, but also simply those who have had the opportunity to meet her eye, are immediately struck by the **energy** and **enthusiasm** she spreads. It is an infectious vitality for all those who work in the company and whom she considers as a family.

The book is an excellent Christmas gift: **it is a source of pride and a responsibility for Mrs Tamburini** to be able to be a source of inspiration, perhaps for young women who want to build a future for themselves. The 'lady of fresh pasta made in Romagna' emphasised that commitment, willingness, and passion are necessary ingredients for success in life and, above all, for being able to face life with **satisfaction** and **determination**.
